2. Welcome & Introductions
3. Treasurer's Report: There was an error on the September Treasurer's Report. Total was revised to read \$11,857.01. Bake sale, Booster Club and Fan Clothe totals were received bringing the budget to \$12,505.31 as of today. Deposits from Kroger Rewards (over \$200), a donation from Jamie Hand with Country Companies of \$100 will go on updated January report.  - e. Script Gift Card: Fliers and order forms will be sent home at the end of the month prior to Thanksgiving break.
 - f. Christmas Manner's Luncheon: Jackie Kaiser is running the luncheon with help from Laura Muir. Napkins, cups, plates and table clothes will be purchased.
 - g. Children's Ball: PTO looking for possible different locations along with a possible February date.
 - h. Movie Night: This event will not be offered this year.
 - i. Winter Carnival: Amy will post about class baskets with a possible sign up genius sent out before Thanksgiving.
6. Project Blacktop: This remains an ongoing project. Work is to continue until it snows. The track and some artwork is currently completed.
7. Spirit Wear: The Booster Club will be releasing new spirit wear.
8. Wal-Mart Grant/Amazon Smile/Kroger Rewards: Stacy stated a teacher needs to apply for Walmart Grant.
